





#### **Impact Grant Award**

The Bismarck Optimist Club is proud to announce that Mystic Smiles, a new pediatric dental clinic supported by the Bismarck State College (BSC) Foundation, has been selected as a recipient of the 2025 Optimist Impact Grant. Mystic Smiles will receive \$5,000 to transform its pediatric dental waiting area into a safe, engaging, and developmentally supportive space for local youth.

The Optimist Impact Grant awards up to two \$5,000 grants annually to local nonprofit initiatives that make a direct and lasting impact on local youth. This year, Mystic Smiles stood out for its focus on addressing disparities in children's oral health care access and creating a welcoming environment for patients. The \$5,000 check was presented to Mystic Smiles on Wednesday, Sept. 17.


The grant will fund the creation of a child-friendly waiting area, including an interactive light board, a sensory learning wall, tree bookshelves, and tooth stools. This space will help children—especially those from underserved backgrounds—form positive associations with dental care.

Mystic Smiles began serving patients in June 2025, working with referrals through partnerships with Bridging the Dental Gap, Ronald McDonald Care Mobile, and Bismarck-Burleigh Public Health. In addition, Mystic Smiles will serve as a teaching clinic for dental assisting and dental hygiene students, giving them hands-on experience in trauma-informed, patient-centered care.
